50-50 SYNC CIC has generated many positive outcomes and notable impact whilst working at Iqra Primary School since 2011. They've delivered a high quality package of intervention programmes, systems, methods and tools, which support and motivate the pupils. This has helped to further enhance the pupils social, emotional learning and personal development. The company has supported and contributed towards the school's progression which reflected in the Ofsted judgment in 2016 as Good with the one outstanding feature being personal development.

50-50's dynamic programmes include a well-structured break and lunchtime zones promoting safe play whilst enabling pupils to practice responsibility and leadership; a high quality and well evidenced intensive pupil support programme for vulnerable and challenging pupils and the delivery of PE lessons which have been observed during internal inspections and by Ofsted to outstanding levels.

They've developed a character skill-based system which has been instrumental in supporting and integrating disadvantaged pupils and those with SEND. Overall this has positively impacted learning, attainment and behaviour throughout the School.

The break and lunchtime zones have created a much calmer and safer environment both outdoors and within the classroom. Pupils feel safe and there has been a significant reduction in behavioural and first aid incidents. Their successful Intensive Pupil Support (IPS) programme has enabled many pupils to re-engage in learning and prevented almost certain fixed term and permanent exclusions.

Their excellent communication with parent/carers has notably improved school/home partnerships. I would highly recommend 50-50 SYNC to all schools, who could also benefit in ways which significantly enhance every pupils social, emotional learning and personal development outcomes.
